Superintendent's Report

- Nashua is now part of the Roose-Valley SPED Co-op. This includes speech/OT/PT/psych services and hearing screenings, K-1 assessments.
- Classroom desks/tables/chairs arrived that were purchased with the ELC grant.
- MSU students pursuing a teaching degree will be coming October 8th-12th to our area for practicum with the idea of eventually getting them as student teachers. This process will help with emergency certification and to get potential teachers in our district.
- Applied for Health Grants which will provide supplies to the community, such as blood pressure monitors
- Safety Grant \$9500 funding would be used next August to provide staff training for school safety
- Stone Tihista sprayed for weeds on the playground. She will need to spray for a few years to get rid of the problem.
- FFA The \$7500 in grant funding arrived to be used for the FFA stipend, coats for students, conference fees, etc.
