#### • Bus Purchase

Verlin mentioned replacing the North route bus for a year or so with our current 2016 14 passenger bus that has mainly been used for activities. The 2014 Wiota bus would be the next bus that needs to be replaced. His quotes showed that a 47 passenger (\$130,000) is cheaper than a 42 passenger. If we order a 14 passenger, we could possibly have it by March. Estimated arrival time for a 47 passenger bus if we order now would be April 2025.
