It was a hard decision, but she had to do what was best for her kids. She was frustrated with this year and did not feel heard when voicing her concerns.

Other issues include: Security system, electrical, water damage, doors, etc. John Bach referred her to SDI architecture for a full assessment, with a possible capital improvement plan.
