New Business:

• North Bus Route

Sheila is on the Transportation Committee. She researched through OPI, MCA, and Nashua bus route policy. 300-foot visibility is referenced. Could the County possibly put up school bus signs ahead of the stop? She talked to Randy Isaakson at the County about plowing that road, he said it is not possible. In 2022 the bus stop changed from Ossette Rd to grain church because of district boundaries. Roger Trang (route driver) said the small bus can turn around on Novak rd. Kayla said their stop is the end of bus route and a safety is an issue with the current route, so the bus should be able to go into their driveway and turn around.

Laptops/Chromebooks Purchase

The District would need 5 laptops for board members, plus 3 for contracted services, and 2 extra to have on hand. 10 laptops total. ESSER funds are already allocated for technology. The Board would like to wait for a quote from MTS.

• Security/Door System Upgrade

One option is \$64,000 to upgrade the entire door/security system. The second option is \$1000 more for a server which is separate from the current server controlling everything else. The Board would like to see if it is possible to use ESSER funding to purchase this system.
