

Greetings from Carroll College!

The Office of Financial Aid is proud to announce the availability of the **2010-2011 Father Sladich Memorial Scholarship**. This **\$1,000 to \$3,000 scholarship** is available to new Carroll students who attend on a full-time basis and is renewable through degree completion as long as the recipient remains in good academic standing and continues to have demonstrated financial need. Preference in awarding this scholarship will go to Montana residents.

In order to be eligible for the scholarship, students must:

- Show verification of enrollment with a Native American Tribe;
- Meet the February 15<sup>th</sup> priority admission deadline;
- Complete and return the Fr. Sladich scholarship application by March 1st.

In addition to special scholarships like the Fr. Sladich Scholarship, Carroll offers merit and need-based financial assistance. Our **merit scholarships for 2010-2011 range from \$8,000 to \$11,500** for new freshmen and from \$4,000 to \$9,000 for new transfer students and are renewable through degree completion. An official financial aid award letter is offered to the students once they have been accepted for admission and have submitted their results of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to Carroll College. However, Carroll offers an early estimate option. Students can complete the **Early Aid Estimator** form on-line or print out a copy to be returned to our office for processing. The results of the early aid estimator will give students a sneak preview of their estimated federal and institutional financial aid.
